

- NetFami is a nationwide participatory project planned for three years with the goal to jointly improve childrens' health
- · The project is aimed at families with children
- Family centers and kitas are social institutions that will participate and work together with the families and the qualified employees
- · The institutions are accompanied regionally
- · Nationwide implementation in nine Kitas and family centers
- · Duration of the project: 2020 2022
- · Coordination by transfer e.V. in Cologne
- · Financing by the Federal Ministry of Health
- Scientific support is given by the University of Applied Sciences for Health in Bochum

Contents and methods

- The qualified staff is continuously trained in the field of participation
- Various participation formats are carried out in respective institutions and in social surroundings to foster health activities
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Putting into practice activities that have been developed with the families
- Merging and processing the different projects' results for further work in the institutions

- Certification of family centres and day care centres in the field of health
- Promoting children's and employees' health
- Establishment of a health promotion culture and formation of a health profile in the day care centres and family centres
- Implementation of a 12-month qualification process with individual training,
 coaching and practical phases
- Orientation towards the existing ressources and the framework of the facilities
- Concept developement by a specialist group and transfer e.V. with expertise from the Federal Centre for Health Education (BZgA)





Basic Assumption

Participatory health education in schools


- "Health-oriented participation teams" contribute to the sustainable improvement of health and educational opportunities, well-being and performance of all in the school setting


